Hard to tip against APPENZELL (3) following her red-hot 29.92 all the way heat victory. MEPUNGA SCARLETT (8) justified her big betting plunge with a comfortable heat win. VALENZUELA (1) scored an emphatic 30.17 heat win off this exact draw.

WARM HUGS (3) can settle just off the speed, make a mid race move and prove hard to hold out. Both FLYING BATTY (5) and CANYA DIVERSION (6) are the two most talented sprinters in this line-up but the draw brings them back to the field.

MR MIYAGI (1) is a dog on the rise and following his best of the day Geelong win on Monday he is a big chance to taste city success here. ZIPPING THERON (2) can settle on the speed and looks a must for any top 3 SRM players.

COMBO COL (5) was the pick of the heat winners and he is proven around this circuit. WHITE OWL (1) overcome early trouble in his strong heat win. TAMGATA BALE (2) once fully balanced is hard to keep up with in the early stages.

MEPUNGA TULLY (1) should be high balling out in front running well below sub 30 seconds and it will take something special to run her down. GRAND TOURER (5) is drawn to get cover early and can camp behind the top elect.

SUCCEED (5) is an extremely gifted type and if he can head down the back straight within a few lengths of the leaders he may just prove too strong in the run home. READ THE ROOM (3) looks the likely leader and will be better for last weeks run.

FRED ROSE (3) has raced at the top level for quite some time now and will find this more to his liking. FLED THE SCENE (4) can produce some big runs when given clear air and looks the next best. DISHEVELLED (6) can explode once fully balanced.

8 SPORTSBET HT2 9:01PM (VIC time) Grade 5 Heat 1st: \$6,800, 2nd: \$2,095, 3rd: \$1,050, 4th: \$150 600 Metres

UTRILLO BALE (7) beat a quality line up over the sprint distance at Sandown Park last week and should have no problem with the step up in distance. HIS SPECIAL (3) is back in top form and is a must for top 3 SRM players.

9 SILVER CHIEF FINAL 9:25PM (VIC time) S/E Group 1 1st: \$75,000, 2nd: \$22,000, 3rd: \$11,000, 4th: \$5,500 525 Metres

Speed map indicates that it is going to be a tight tussle for the early lead and with the aid of the gun draw GIACOMO (1) could just have enough speed to hold them out going into the all important first bend. DEADLY AVANGER (2) is a serious prospect.

10 REECE 9:52PM (VIC time) Grade 5 1st: \$5,900, 2nd: \$1,820, 3rd: \$915, 4th: \$150 525 Metres

Looks a race in two. WHERE'S POPPY (2) ran a flying first split from a tough draw when recording a red-hot overall 29.14 at Sandown Park last week and looks the one to beat. GAMBELLA (1) was enormous when runner up here last week.

PAW WHITLEY (2) can show superior early speed and could be off and gone as they enter the back straight. MAIA (1) can get a nice sit behind the top elect and make a race of it. CAMP FIRE (6) rarely runs a bad race around this circuit.
