REPORT

Stewards on the 13th March 2015, conducted an Inquiry into the circumstances pertaining to the late scratching of the greyhound 'Bekim Girl' from the Cranbourne meeting held on the 28th January 2015.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mrs Andrea Dailly with a breach of GAR86 (o) in that she negligently failed to present the greyhound 'Bekim Girl' for its engagement in an event at the Cranbourne Greyhound Racing Club meeting on the 28th January 2015, which resulted in the greyhound becoming a late scratching.

Mrs Dailly pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mrs Dailly guilty as charged and fined her \$600.00.
