Offence: The person in charge of a greyhound must keep and retain

records detailing all vaccinations, antiparasitics and medical treatments administered to a greyhound from the time the greyhound enters their care until the greyhound leaves their care for a minimum of 2 years. Such records of treatment must be produced for inspection when requested by a Steward or a person authorised by the controlling body. Any person responsible for a greyhound at a relevant time who fails to comply with any provision of this rule shall be guilty

of an offence.

## **REPORT**

Stewards on the 23 June 2015, conducted an Inquiry into Mr. William Ferguson's failure to present treatment records for the greyhound "Gaelic Flyer" when requested to by GRV Steward Mr. Ron Matthews during a kennel inspection conducted on 8 March 2015.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr. Ferguson with a breach of GAR 84(a)(1) in that as the person in charge of the greyhound "Gaelic Flyer" he did fail to keep and retain records detailing medical treatments administered to the greyhound under his care and was unable to produce such records when requested to by Steward Mr. Ron Matthews during an inspection conducted on 8 March 2015.

Mr. Ferguson pleaded not guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr. Ferguson guilty as charged and fined him \$200.00.
