## **REPORT**

Stewards on 11 May 2015 conducted an Inquiry into an alleged incident that occurred between Mr Coleman and another registered person at the Cranbourne Greyhound Racing Club meeting conducted on 25 February 2015.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr Coleman with a breach of GAR86 (q) in that he did engage in conduct which was detrimental to the image and promotion of greyhound racing by making inappropriate contact with another registered person and behaving in a manner which was inappropriate

Mr Coleman pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr Coleman guilty as charged and fined him the sum of \$250 and issued a 1 month suspension wholly suspended for 6 months pending no further breaches of GAR 86.
