Greyhound: Gaelic Flyer
GAR: 84 (a)(4)(b)
Offence: It shall be an offence for any person other than a veterinary surgeon to possess, prescribe, administer or allow to be administered to any greyhound, any schedule 4 or schedule 8 substance listed in the standard for the uniform scheduling of medicines and poisons contained in the Australian poisons standard, as amended from time to time.

REPORT

Stewards on the 23 June 2015, conducted an Inquiry into Mr. William Ferguson administering testoprop (testosterone) a schedule 4 substance to the greyhound "Gaelic Flyer".

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr. Ferguson with a breach of GAR 84(a)(4)(b) in that he did administer testoprop (testosterone) a schedule 4 substance to the greyhound "Gaelic Flyer" on or about 9 February 2015 without providing evidence testoprop was prescribed by a veterinary surgeon for the greyhound.

Mr. Ferguson pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr. Ferguson guilty as charged and fined him \$400.00.
