REPORT

Following advice from Racing Analytical Services Laboratory, the Stewards of Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV), conducted an investigation into the results of an out of competition urine sample taken from the greyhound 'Why Not Lucy', which was found to contain the Permanantly Banned Prohibited Substance Morphine. This sample was taken during the course of a kennel inspection conducted by Greyhound Racing Victoria Stewards at the property of Mr Wayne Gray.

Stewards heard evidence from Dr. Steven Karamatic GRV Industry Veterinarian.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr Gray in breach of GAR 79A(4)(i) in that the greyhound "Why Not Lucy" was found not to be free of the Permanantly Prohibited Banned Substance Morphine.

Mr Gray pleaded not guilty to the charge.

After hearing all the evidence tendered, Stewards detemind that Mr Gray was guilty as charged and disqualified him for 3 months, effective from Tuesday 28 April 2015.
