REPORT

Stewards on the 27 February, conducted an Inquiry into the circumstances pertaining to the Late Scratching of the greyhound Aeroplane Lou from the Horsham Greyhound Racing Club meeting held on Tuesday 3 February 2015.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr Finn in breach of GAR86 (o) in that he nominated the greyhound Aeroplane Lou before it was officially cleared to race by a clearance officer, which in the opinion of stewards was negligent.

Mr Finn pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr Finn guilty as charged and severely reprimanded him.
