REPORT

Stewards on the 8th June & 6th July, 2015, conducted an Inquiry into an incident that occurred at the Ballarat Greyhound Racing Club meeting on 8th June, 2015 involving Mr. Brad Weightman, Mr. Tristan New and Ms. Johanna Matthyssen.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr. Weightman with a breach of GAR86 (q) in that he did send a message via 'Facebook' to Mr. New which in the opinion of stewards, the content was detrimental to the interest and image of greyhound racing.

Mr. Weightman pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr. Weightman guilty as charged and suspended his licence for three (3) months with two (2) months wholly suspended for 12 months pending no further breaches of GAR 86(q).
