REPORT

Stewards on the 8th June & 6th July, 2015, conducted an Inquiry into an incident that occurred at the Ballarat Greyhound Racing Club meeting on 8th June, 2015 involving Ms. Johanna Matthyssen, Mr. Tristan New and Mr. Brad Weightman.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Ms Matthyssen with a breach of GAR86 (q) in that she did engage in conduct (Inappropriate Language) towards/about Mr. New which in the opinion of stewards was detrimental to the interest and image of greyhound racing.

Ms Matthyssen pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Ms Matthyssen guilty as charged and fined her \$250.00 wholly suspended for 12 months pending no further breaches of GAR 86(g).
