<u>REPORT</u>

Stewards on the 8th June & 6th July, 2015, conducted an Inquiry into an incident that occurred at the Ballarat Greyhound Racing Club meeting on 8th June, 2015 involving Mr. Tristan New, Ms. Johanna Matthyssen and Mr. Brad Weightman.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr. New with a breach of GAR86 (q) in that he did engage in conduct (Inappropriate Language) towards Ms Matthyssen which in the opinion of stewards was detrimental to the interest and image of greyhound racing.

Mr. New pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr. New guilty as charged and fined him \$250.00 wholly suspended for 12 months pending no further breaches of GAR 86(q).
