REPORT

Stewards on the 27 February, conducted an inquiry into the circumstances in which Mr Johnston, who was the trainer and handler of Magic Shuffle in event number 9 at the Bendigo Greyhound Racing Association meeting on the 18 June 2014, when in the opinion of Stewards was intoxicated, which was detrimental to the image, interest and control of Greyhound Racing.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr Johnston in breach of GAR 86(q) in that he engaged in conduct detrimental to the image, interest and control of Greyhound Racing at the Bendigo Greyhound Racing track on 18 June 2014.

Mr Johnston pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr Johnston guilty as charged and disqualified him for a period of 2 months.
