REPORT

Stewards on the 23 March, 2015 conducted an Inquiry into an alleged breach of GAR 86 (q) involving an incident that was reported to stewards at the Ballarat Greyhound track involving the manner in which Mr Davison handled his greyhound at a trialling session on 24 January 2015.

Stewards heard evidence from Mr. Davison, trainers Mr John Galea, Mr Dale Bunn, Ms Renee New, Mr Travis Monaghan and Mr Garry White.

After considering the evidence, Stewards deemed there was insufficient evidence to find Mr Davison guilty of any malicious or intentional behaviour that would constitute a breach of 86 (q).
