REPORT

On Thursday, 1st of July 2024, Investigative Stewards held an Inquiry with Mr John Macri relating to the rehoming of greyhound ACCOUNTANT (NJFTN), who was at the time a greyhound owned by Mr John Macri. The greyhound left the care of the owner, and was subsequently adopted to a third-party, without being sterilised by a veterinarian. The civilian third-party adopting ACCOUNTANT (NJFTN) engaged in alleged deceptive conduct that the chairman accepted to be true and proved to be a mitigating factor in this investigation.

On Tuesday, 9th of July 2024, Chairman Mr Dylan Bartolo held a Stewards Hearing with Mr John Macri relating to the abovementioned charge. Mr John Macri entered a plea of not guilty to the charge. Mr Macri made the Chairman aware of additional evidence that he indicated he would rely on that wasn't readily available for consideration. As a result, the Stewards Hearing was adjourned.

On Wednesday the 14th of August 2024, Chairman Mr Dylan Bartolo recalled the Stewards Hearing. The additional evidence was presented, and corroborated Mr Marci's position.

The charges are as follows:

CHARGE 1

Greyhounds Australasia Rules (GAR) 24 (1)

Unless a greyhound is being accepted by an adoption agency approved by a Controlling Body that undertakes sterilisation, the owner or person responsible for the greyhound at the time of such retirement as a pet must ensure that the greyhound has been surgically sterilised by a veterinarian before allowing the greyhound to leave their care and custody, except where a veterinarian certifies after examining that greyhound, to the satisfaction of a Controlling Body, that being surgically sterilised would be detrimental to its welfare.

Mr Macri pleaded not guilty to the charge. The charge was found proven.

PENALTY

NB: Steward Investigation/Hearing decisions are subject to Appeal under the Rules of Greyhound Racing.



Charge 1

- \$200 fine (\$200 wholly suspended for 12 months).

In determining penalty, the Chairman considered several factors namely:

- Mr John Macri's not guilty plea and cooperation during the investigation.
- Mr Macri's prior history of compliance.
- Prompt series of events and actions Mr Macri took after realising an offence had occurred.

- Additional evidence presented corroborating Mr Macri's position.
- Specific and general deterrence.
