<u>REPORT</u>

On Monday 25 November 2024, GRV Stewards finalised an inquiry into the conduct of licensed person Mr. Kevin Gavin in relation to an incident that occurred at the Warrnambool Greyhound Racing Club race meeting on 16 September 2024.

Stewards heard evidence from Mr. Kevin Gavin and viewed CCTV footage of the incident. After considering all of the evidence, Stewards issued Mr. Gavin a charge under GAR 165(a), which reads;

GAR 165 - Conduct detrimental to the interests of greyhound racing. An offence is committed if a person (including an official): (a) commits or omits to do any act or engages in conduct which is in any way detrimental or prejudicial to the interest, welfare, image, control or promotion of greyhound racing;

The particulars being that at the Warrnambool Greyhound Racing Club race meeting on 16 September 2024, Mr. Kevin Gavin, being a registered person with GRV;

- a) Engaged in a hostile and aggressive verbal argument with another licensed participant in the kennel block prior to Race 13; and/or
- b) Made unnecessary and deliberate physical contact with another licensed participant in a hostile manner in the kennel block prior to race 13.

Mr. Gavin pleaded not guilty to the charge. Mr. Gavin was found guilty as charged. After considering submissions on penalty, Mr. Gavin was issued a fine of \$500 for the offence, with \$200 suspended for twelve (12) months, pending no further behavioral related offences during this time.

In determining penalty, Stewards took into consideration:

- Mr. Gavin's record with GRV.
- General and specific deterrence.
- The circumstances surrounding the commission of the offence.
